Internships at the Alfred

The Alfred Health Pharmacy Department provides a comprehensive and modern intern training program at one of Australia's most eminent Clinical Pharmacy services.

Our interns learn in a department which is at the leading edge of Pharmacy practice, side-by-side with some of Australia's most advanced Clinical Pharmacists.

KEY FEATURES

- Ÿ Over 75% of internship is spent in clinical areas
- ÿ Core rotations through general medicine, surgery, cardiology and aged care
- Ÿ An opportunity to complete a clinical elective in a specialty of your choice
- Ÿ Rotations through inpatient dispensary, outpatient dispensary, aseptic preparations and medicines information
- Ÿ Weekly intern education meetings
- Ÿ Dedicated Supervisor (usually a younger pharmacist) allocated to each intern to provide guidance and advice
- Ÿ Four oral practice exams run by the department under exam conditions, to simulate the real environment

About the pharmacy department

Over 100 pharmacists and 30 support staff enable the Alfred Health pharmacy department to provide a 7 day a week, comprehensive clinical pharmacy service through a variety of clinical specialty areas.

The Alfred's statewide services include heart and lung replacement and transplantation, cystic fibrosis, burns, HIV/AIDS, haemophilia, sexual health, hyperbaric medicine and elective surgery.

CLINICAL PHARMACY SERVICES

Clinical pharmacy services are organised in a unit-based model, with clinical pharmacists operating as part of an integrated team, side-by-side with medical, nursing and allied health staff.

Examples of innovative practices provided by our pharmacists include:

- Ÿ Ordering lab tests and independently adjusting doses for therapeutic drug monitoring and warfarin
- Ÿ Assessing nicotine dependency and prescribing nicotine replacement therapy
- Y Assessing post-operative pain and independently adjusting opioid doses
- Ÿ Attending stroke thrombolysis call-outs and assist in the management of thrombolysis
- Ÿ Attending sepsis call-outs and charting antibiotics following consultation with the team

Opportunities at the Alfred after your internship

The Alfred Health Pharmacy Department clinical services are supported by research, educational initiatives and a career progression model. To facilitate this, the following programs are available:

Ÿ Clinical pharmacy fellowship:

- A two year program designed to facilitate progression to advanced practice in a specific clinical specialty
- ^c Includes scholarship funding towards the Master of Clinical Pharmacy (MClinPharm) at Monash University

Ÿ Clinical pharmacy PhD program:

- Designed to give pharmacists the opportunity and support to undertake a research program as a fundamental component of their current practice and appointment
- Supported by department to complete a parttime PhD with Monash University
